Monday, October 5th, 2026 Welcome to the childcare program and immerse yourself in the world of your own creativity

Project4Kidz: The Architecture Workshop

Today it's time to roll up our sleeves and get creative! In our invention workshop, children discover their imagination, curiosity, and problem-solving skills. In everyday life, which is often highly structured, there is little room for free thinking and creative exploration – this is exactly where our project comes in. Children are encouraged to experiment, plan, rethink ideas, and find their own solutions. In doing so, they experience the value of their ideas and strengthen their self-confidence and sense of self-efficacy.

The day begins with an inspiring story from a child-friendly book about inventions and imaginative constructions. Afterwards, the children design and build their own fantasy houses using materials from the Project4Kidz kit. In the afternoon, movement games provide balance and energy, complemented by free playtime. This creates a varied, child-centered program that combines creativity, movement, and free play.

Tuesday, October 6th, 2026 Welcome to the City of Tomorrow

Project4Kidz: The City of Tomorrow

How will we live, work, and spend our free time in the future? In our project "The City of Tomorrow", children embark on an exciting journey into the world of the future.

The day begins with a child-friendly story or nonfiction book about sustainable cities, new technologies, and innovative building ideas. Afterwards, the children become city planners themselves: using large sheets of paper, colors, craft materials, and lots of imagination, they design their own future city with houses, parks, playgrounds, and transportation systems. In small "city tours," the children proudly present their designs and learn to explain their ideas with confidence. A special highlight is creating homemade "future glasses," which allow them to explore imaginative worlds. Movement games and free playtime round off the day.

Wednesday, October 7th, 2026 Welcome to your Dream Bridge

Project4Kidz: My Dream Bridge Construction

Today, children dive into the exciting world of building and construction, with a focus on bridges and small structures. Through playful activities, we encourage teamwork, logical thinking, spatial awareness, and manual skills.

At the beginning, the children plan their own bridge model on paper, thinking about which materials they need, how long their bridge should be, and how stability can be achieved. Then it's time to build: using wooden sticks, paper, glue, string, and other materials, the children create individual bridge models. By experimenting, they learn which shapes are especially strong and how small changes can have a big impact.

After the construction phase, the bridges are creatively designed and decorated. To conclude, the children present their projects and talk about their ideas. Free play and movement activities round off this varied day.
